# The NETest Testing Process

The NETest is a blood-based neuroendocrine cancer diagnostic that can be used to help diagnose, recommend treatment, and then monitor progress for neuroendocrine tumor (NET) or neuroendocrine neoplasia (NEN) patients in real-time.

### LOCAL LABORATORY/DOCTORS OFFICE



**1.** Obtain a requisition from your physician and get your blood sample drawn at your local laboratory.



**2.** The blood sample with the requisition form is sent via overnight courier to the clinical testing laboratory at Wren Laboratories, Branford, CT.

### WREN LABORATORY



**3.** The laboratory performs all testing necessary to generate a NETest result – typically takes two full days.



**4.** Once the NETest result is produced and verified, it is sent to your doctor.

### CLINICAL INSTITUTION/DOCTORS OFFICE



**5.** Your doctor interprets the NETest result in conjunction with other clinical assessments.



**6.** Your doctor notifies you of the results.
